The mini-web server (WEBrick) that comes bundled with Rails listens on port 3000 by default. However, since there are several students in the class who will likely be using the Rails server at the same time, each student will execute the server on a unique port to prevent collisions with other students' copies of the server.

The Rails server can be started with a custom port number via the following command:

```
rails server -p port
```
